She is the Delhi university topper in M.Sc. by acquiring 100% marks in “Integral Equation and Boundary Value Problem”. She has published over 80 research papers, 2 books and edited 1 proceedings of international conference. She has supervised 10 PhD scholars and 5 research scholar are presently pursuing PhD under her supervision. In addition to a referee for many international journals of repute and life member of several international organizations in the sphere of mathematical sciences, she is managing editor of Indian Journal of Industrial and Applied Mathematics. She has attended and delivered talks and chaired sessions at reputed academic conferences and workshops across the world.
